

Seasonal Site Rules and Regulations

Failure to comply with these policies and regulations will be considered a breach of the camper agreement, and will result in eviction from the campsite without refund of the paid seasonal fees.

Visitors

- Please be sure to advise your visitors that there is a fee to avoid any confusion at the office check-in.
- All guests must be registered at the office before entering the campground.
 - Day Pass \$3 per person, 8 a.m.-11 p.m.
 - Over Night \$8 per person, 8 a.m.– 11 p.m. the next day
- Visitors who stay less than an hour will get a refund.
- Any Guest who is on the campground without being registered will be charged **double** the normal guest fee.
- As the seasonal camper, it is your responsibility to assure that all day and over night guests have properly registered.
- Visitors are not permitted in the park without the registered seasonal camper's permission
 - Permission should be given at the office.
- All visitors must park in the designated visitor parking area.

Conduct

- Alcohol is only permitted for those 21 years old and over, excessive drinking/intoxication may lead to eviction.
- Children (18 and under) must be on a campsite with a responsible adult by 11 pm.
- Persons 18 and under cannot be left in the campground without adult supervision.
- Construction of decks/awnings must be performed during weekdays in June/July/August unless you have been allowed otherwise by management.
- Wildwood strictly enforces its Zero Tolerance Policy.
 - Threatening behavior by campers is unacceptable. No profanity, excessive noise or other unsuitable behavior is permitted at any time. No person shall willfully damage any public or private property, buildings or other.
- Smoking is not permitted inside **ANY** building or at the swim areas.
- No illegal drugs, fire-arms, bow n' arrow, and b-b guns are allowed on the resort and instances result in immediate eviction.

Garbage & Recycling

- We have cardboard, glass and bottle recycling. Please dispose of your trash accordingly.
- As you have noticed we have changed the way we do garbage. We ask that you take large items to the large garbage dumpster.
- The dumpsters are intended for camper's trash while they are camping, not for trash brought in from elsewhere.
- DO NOT LITTER. Please be respectful of the grounds and pick up any trash you may see laying on the ground.
- PLEASE do not place garbage in the Bathroom bins.

General

- No Dogs except on designated dog weekends.
- Quiet time is from 11 pm– 8am
 - All outside lights and lanterns are to be turned off during these hours, except for small LED or "Christmas" lighting.
- No one on the playground after Dusk.
- Wildwood Resort is not responsible for campground users' losses, injuries or accidents, theft, fire, weather, ect.
- Gate hours are from 8 am-11pm.
- The bay is a NO-Wake Zone.
- Do **NOT** litter!
- The store is closed on Sunday.
 - This includes all sales, wood, gas, ice and boat rentals.

Maintenance & Site

- Sites must be kept clean, neat and tidy at all times.
- Fire pits are not garbage cans!
- Sites must be cleaned before leaving the site; all garbage and recyclable material bagged and put in garbage bins provided.
- No object, wire or rope may be attached to/or between trees.
- All lawn ornaments must be approved by management.

Refunds & Late Fees

- The \$500.00 deposit is non-refundable and cannot be used for any other function under any circumstance.
- You must contact us by April 1st if you are not able to camp for the season. If you have notified us by April 1st, and your trailer is out of the campground BY April 1st, we will refund any money paid toward site fees with exception of the \$500.00 deposit.
- If you do not contact us before April 1st, that you will not be able to camp, you will lose your \$500.00 deposit. You will be responsible for removing your trailer from the campground by April opening weekend or you will be charged daily rates accordingly.
- If for any reason you can no longer camp with us, no refund will be applied after April payment or June payment. The seasonal rate is split into two segments for your convenience and is not a reflection of costs for those particular individual months but an overall total. A late fee of \$25.00 will be applied weekly to overdue balances unless management has been properly contacted. After three weeks of non-payment you will lose your campsite and risk your trailer being towed to storage.

Fires

- Fires may be allowed (subject to County Fire Marshall Approval)
- No unoccupied fires, must be extinguished if unattended.
- Fires must be in the fire rings
- Do not relocate firepits

Camping & Site Regulations

- Any improvements (decks, patios, sheds, ect) are subject to approval by Wildwood Management.
- We do allow tents. Only one small tent (max 8'x 8') is allowed per site. No permanent tents are allowed.
- We do not allow a second RV unit on one site. This includes tent trailers, camper trucks.
- Please know that when you are no longer camping with us, you will be responsible for removing any decks or screen rooms, as well as the camping unit and any other material.
- You can sell your trailer on site and the site may come w/ the trailer as long as the new customer is approved by management.
- In case of a trailer sale and a new customer takes over the trailer and site, Wildwood takes ownership rights to any landscaping material and paved surfaces and structures, excluding decks and awnings.

Trailer Regulations

- Trailers, awnings and deck structures must be kept in good shape and structurally sound.
- RV sewer connections must be a piped connection w/ a sealed connection (threaded or gasket) to Wildwood sewer pipe.
- Do not leave your waste valves open during use, let tanks build up and when full slowly open valve for discharge into the septic system.

Swimming Regulations

- Swimming is only allowed in designated swimming areas.
- Swim at your own risk
- There is **NO** lifeguard on duty. It is your responsibility to watch your child while swimming.
- An adult must accompany children under 14 at all times while swimming.
- **NO** swimming off the gas or boat docks.
- No swimming after Dusk.

Messages & Mail

- Phone Messages and envelope mail may be picked up at the office.
- Only emergency messages will be relayed to seasonal guests.
- Packages can be mailed to our location, a \$5 handling charge applies and pickup/payment is at the store/office.

Bicycles, Scooters Skateboards, and Others

Scooting around is fun, we want to make sure its safe for everyone. Please be aware of these policies.

- No Bicycle riding after dark. No stunts or tricks are to be performed on Wildwood grounds. Please do not ride at excessive speed and or/ recklessness.
- There is no place to skateboard in the campground. Therefore they are not allowed in the campground.
- All riders under 16 must wear helmets. We strongly urge all ages to wear a helmet. No stunts or tricks are to be performed on Wildwood grounds.
- All drivers must have a valid driver's license. NO off road vehicles allowed.
- No four-wheeled vehicles (ATV's) allowed.
- No gas powered scooters allowed.
- Only electric scooters allowed, no horseplay on scooters.
- No riding near or around entrance/ exit gate.
- Do not ride inside any of the campground buildings.
- DO not block roadways or building entrances with equipment.
- Any repeated offenses will result in loss of riding privileges.

Traffic

- Seasonal Passes must be displayed on vehicles at all times.
- Speed Limit is 5 Mph. If you are driving or riding faster then you can walk, you are going to fast!
- This is a family campground, Please watch out for children at play!

Pets

- Pets are only allowed on designated dog weekend. There is no exception to this rule. Those who choose to disregard this rule will be asked to leave.
- Please be respectful to others and their pets.
 - Pick up immediately after your dog.
 - All dogs must be on a leash.
 - Dogs are not allowed in the cabins, yurt, swim area or any other public building
- Any dog that is reckless or harmful to any persons on the Resort must be taken off the Resort.
- Dogs owners must be walking their own dogs, no kids or other dog walkers.
- No Aggressive Breeds allowed, see store for details.
